

HAY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR HORSE OWNERS

DCTC (Dream Catcher Therapy Center, Inc.) has Hay bank (Western Slope Hay bank) to help horse owners who are trying to hang on to the family's horses during hard times. The Hay Bank is provided through private donations and grants through the Colorado Unwanted Horse Alliance (CUHA), and The Lauretta Boyd Charitable Trust. This is for anyone struggling to feed or care for their horses due to economic hardship of any kind. The price of the hay is determined due to need and resources. Need is determined through the application process. We don't want anyone or any horse to go without their basic needs being met. The criteria for consideration are:

- 1. Complete the Hay Assistance Program application which can be downloaded at www.dctc.org Email, fax or Mail in or completed application. Application can be found on the website or we can send you one.
- 2. Site visit and verification of all documents.
- 3. No evidence of abuse or neglect of the animal
- 4. Must want to keep the horse
- 5. Able to pick up your feed at the facility in Olathe, CO
- 6. Store the feed correctly and feed only to the designated animals and not utilized for breeding purposes.

DCTC has the SOLE RIGHT TO DETERMINE ELEGIBILITY.
